



TBAY Fees and Payment Policies

Swimmers new to TBAY who have competed on a previous USA or Florida team must complete a transfer form (<http://www.floridaswimming.org/EF%2008%20Club%20Release%20and%20Transfer%20Form.pdf>) at the time of their registration. Please complete the form and send it directly to the FL Swimming office either via email (FLSOffice2@aol.com) or fax (352-242-5245).

Annual Membership Fee	\$300 Senior Elite/ AG Performance Black \$150 AG Developmental Red and 10&Us *For families with multiple swimmers, one annual TBAY membership fee will cover all siblings but not additional USA/FL Registrations Fees of \$54.00.
Quarterly Swimming Fees¹	Senior, Age 13+: \$360 per quarter Age Group, Age 10-12: \$240 per quarter 2 nd , 3 rd or 4 th Senior, Age 13+: \$324 per quarter * 2 nd , 3 rd or 4 th Age Group, Age 10-12: \$216 per quarter *

*2nd, 3rd, and/or 4th swimmer in same family receives 10% discount.

¹Dues will be collected each quarter no later than the 5th day of the first month of the quarterly session (January, April, July, October).

Registration Payments

- TBAY prefers that swimmers make their dues payments by check, made payable to “**TBAY Central Booster Club.**” Those with an established PayPal online service account can make payment using PayPal: <http://www.tampabayaquatics.com/Make-Payment.htm>. *Note: There will be a 3% surcharge added to all PayPal payments.* For new members, if you choose to pay via PayPal, you must mail this [registration form](#) and a copy of your birth certificate and a printed PayPal receipt to: Treasurer, Carrie Werdine; 5131 West Neptune Way, Tampa FL 33609
- Every TBAY swimmer must be registered with FL/USA Swimming. All swimmers should confirm that their annual membership is up-to-date. If your membership has expired, please fill out [this form](#) and send it along with your fees to Carrie Werdine.

Payment Options

Dues payment either in one check for full amount of three post-dated checks dated the first of each Session's month. Payment is also available via PayPal on our website with a 3% processing charge.

Proration of Dues

- Not applicable to existing and/or returning TBAY swimmers; all dues are paid at the beginning of the Session.
- Dues for first-time TBAY swimmers, who join within a Session, are prorated on a monthly basis.

Penalty for Late Payments

- If dues are not paid by the 20th of the month, a \$25 late fee will be assessed.
- If dues are unpaid for more than 45 days, Board is notified and swimmer is suspended from all membership privileges.
- If dues are unpaid for more than 60 days, member is declared to not be in good standing and membership is terminated (requires Board approval).
- Members terminated in such a fashion must petition the Board for possible re-admittance into TBAY. Such re-admittance will be at the Board's discretion.
- Members should contact a Board member to discuss extenuating circumstances. The Board will address such situations on a case-to-case basis.

Penalty for a Returned Check

TBAY Central members who submit a check that is returned due to insufficient funds will be assessed a \$25 charge.

Meet Entry Payments

Our payment methods encourage a “pay as you go” policy for your swimmer's meet entry fees. Credit cards and escrow account handling are far too time-consuming for effective administration and reconciliation. There is also often a long lag time between meet entries and receipt of checks, credit card payments, and escrow deductions. Meet entry fees must be made at the time of meet entry by:

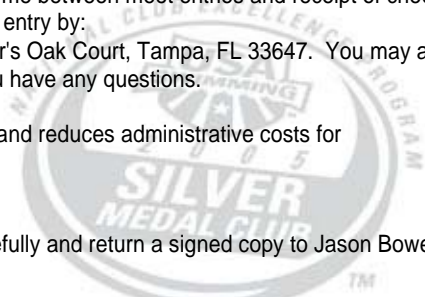
